

**Agro Meteorological Advisories:**

Crop	Crop stage / Pest/Disease	Advisories
Paddy	.-	Puncha is in seedling stage.
Coconut	Management	Mulching can be done with dried or green coconut leaves or coir pith to maintain moisture in coconut gardens. Lower one or two whirls can be cut off to prevent moisture loss from plant. Coconut stem up to two metres can be painted with slaked lime to prevent sun scorching. Organic content in the soil can be ensured for maintaining soil temperature. Drip irrigation shall be adopted.
Ginger, Turmeric and Pepper	Harvesting stage	Harvesting can be initiated in ginger, turmeric, pepper etc. Severe drying of pepper vines can be controlled by providing mulches.
Vegetables	Aphids	The amount of sucking insects will be increasing due to increasing atmospheric temperature. Apply 2% neem oil-garlic-soap emulsion for control of aphids.
Animal Husbandry	Adopt measures to eradicate external parasitic infestations in animals. (CAADECCS, KVASU, Mannuthy)
