

CURRENT SYNOPTIC SITUATION: The trough at mean sea level from comorin area adjoining Malidives area to North Interior Karnataka has become less marked. However, an upper air cyclonic circulation over Malidives – Lakshadweep area upto 1.5 km asl persists.

Agro Meteorological Advisories:

Crop	Stage of the crop / Pest/Disease	Advisories
Rice	Tillering stage/Leaf folder	Leaf folder attack can be controlled using trichogramma cards (2CC per one acre). Cut the cards in to small pieces and fix in different regions of the field. If the attack is severe, spray Quinalphos @ 2ml per one liter of water.
Coconut	Mite Apply 2% neem oil-garlic-soap emulsion in the crown young bunches to prevent mite's attack.	
Banana	Sigatoka	Spray 10-15 gms of Pseudomonas in 1 liter of water to control the disease in the beginning stage. In severe attack, apply 2 gm of SAAF in 1 litre of water.
Nutmeg	Management	Mulching is recommended to protect the trees from drought and sun scorching. Irrigate the plants.
Vegetables (Cowpea)	Thrips	Spray Oberon 0.6 ml/ L of water.
