KAU is pleased to announce a joint Master's programme in collaboration with the University of Western Australia (UWA), offering M.Sc. degree in Environmental Science and Agricultural Economics.

Programme Highlights:

- Open to graduates holding a 4-year Honors degree of KAU.
- The student will study the First year at KAU and the second year of Master's research at the UWA.
- Limited intake: 5 students per programme each year.
- Student selection conducted jointly by KAU and UWA.

Eligibility Criteria:

- OGPA **above 70%** in the first semester.
- Completion of *ENVT4422: Research Methods in Agricultural and Environmental Science* offered by the UWA via online mode with **at least 70% (Distinction)**.
- IELTS score of **6.5 overall**, with no individual band below **6**.
- Knowledge of *ArcGIS* and *R programming*.

Tuition Fees (2025):

- **Master of Environmental Science:** AUD \$49,500 per annum
- **Master of Agricultural Economics:** AUD \$50,700 per annum.

Note: UWA's tuition fees are reviewed each year.

Certification & Expenses:

- Successful students will receive separate certificates from KAU and UWA.
- Students should pay the course fee and associated expenses during the second year at UWA.

First batch of selected students expected at UWA by July 2026.
