- 2. The sealed cover containing the tender should be superscribed "Tender for Honey bee Colony (Apis cerana indica) + boxes" (along with the notification number) and addressed to the Dean, College of Agriculture, Padannakkad.
- 3. Each tender should be accompanied by tender fee and an Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) @ 1% of the total rupee equivalent cost of the quoted items by way of three crossed Demand Drafts separately (1. Tender fee 2.GST on tender fee 3.EMD) drawn in favour of The Dean, College of Agriculture, Padannakkad payable at the State Bank of India, Nileshwar.
